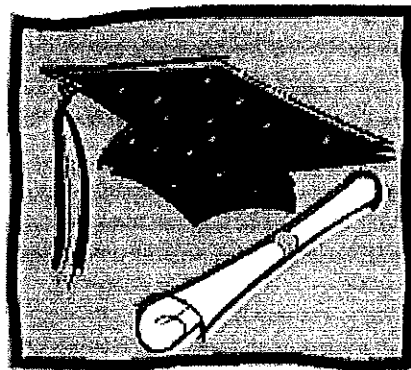

The Homer Henke - John Mull Class of '54 Scholarship

Background

The Homer Henke - John Mull - Class of '54 Scholarship was first awarded to the Class of 2010. It is an annual scholarship based on financial need.

Goal

The goal of the Homer Henke - John Mull - Class of '54 Scholarship is to assist graduating high school seniors from Civic Memorial High School in continuing their education beyond high school at Lewis & Clark Community College. The scholarship amount is \$1,000 per year for up to two years and will be given to two graduating Civic Memorial students, one male and one female.

The scholarship committee reserves the right to withhold the award if there are no qualified applicants.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

The recipients will be selected based on the following:

1. Applicants must be able to show financial need.
2. Applicants must show examples of positive leadership in academics and extracurricular school activities.
3. Eligible applicants shall be graduating seniors, one male and one female.
4. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.
5. Applicants must enroll full-time at LCCC.

Student Selection Process

Applicants must furnish the following:

1. The attached, completed application
2. The attached, completed School & Extracurricular and Community Activity Chart
3. An official high school transcript
4. A one page, typed essay "Why I Should Receive The Homer Henke - John Mull - Class of '54 Scholarship"
5. Two typed and signed reference letters, one letter from a teacher and one letter from a sponsor of your extracurricular activities or community participation

Eligibility for Scholarship Renewal

1. Student must have a minimum 2.0 cumulative LCCC GPA.
2. Student must continue to be enrolled full time.

Applications should be submitted in a sealed envelope to Mrs. Chelsea Zelasko in the counseling office no later than 2:30 p.m. on April 24, 2024.

The Homer Henke - John Mull - Class of '54 Scholarship

This is a two-year renewable scholarship based upon financial need, career aspirations, and other criteria. The value of the scholarship is \$1,000 and is available to two graduating seniors, one male and one female, planning to enroll at Lewis & Clark Community College.
