Each individual that lives at Beverly Farm is provided the supports and services they need to gain independence, participate in determining their future, and enjoy their lives.

An array of assessments and evaluations is provided for each person. This helps the support team of professionals, family, friends, and the individual develop a plan to establish priority supports the individual desires. Required support supervision ranges from twenty-four hours to intermittent supervision.



In 1897, Dr. and Mrs. William Smith searched for a suitable tract of land where they could establish a fundamentally different approach to care for people who lived with intellectual or developmental disabilities.

They found the perfect location in Godfrey, Illinois, where they would offer a caring home, socialization, proper medical care, healthy diet, physical exercise, education, recreation and meaningful work – a radical concept at the time.
